

**Bournemouth Panthers –v- Bransgore
Under Tens Hardball Cricket

Some of the Bransgore players were late arriving so we agreed they would bat first.

Bransgore Innings

Ben Jones bowled the first over and with the first ball took a wicket. A great start. He followed this with wide and four dot balls. Sam Taylor bowled next conceding just one run in a good over. Captain Thomas Cole bowled next and three were scored off the over. Sam Trellis bowled the last over at the first pair, another good over. After one pair Bransgore were on 204 for 1.

Josh Halderthay and Sam Cornish each bowled two overs at the second pair and both bowled really well, each taking a wicket. Josh only conceded two wides and both Sam C's overs were maidens. After two pairs Bransgore were 196 for 3.

The third pair faced overs from Sam Trellis, Sam Taylor, Thomas and then Ben. All four bowled well with a wicket maiden from Sam Taylor, a wicket for Thomas and a maiden from Ben that included two balls that brushed the bails as they flew past. After three pairs Bransgore were 189 for 5.

The last Bransgore pair were their best batsmen. Again the overs were bowled by Sam Trellis, Sam Talyor, Thomas and then Ben. First over Sam Trellis got a wicket, meaning all six bowlers each had a wicket – what a team effort! The last pair ran really well, and Hames Wakefield hit two fours of Sam Trellis and one off Ben in the last over. Bransgore finished on 212 for 6.

Throughout the innings Will Taylor did a great job behind the stumps stopping everything that came his way.

Panthers Innings

The job was to bat sensibly and not lose any wickets. The prize for not losing any wickets was chocolate!

First in were Ben and Josh. They batted sensibly, with some good running, adding 25 to the score without losing any wickets.

Next in were Sam Trellis and Sam Cornish. Again they batted well and Sam T hit a 4, which with the long outfield was a great shot. After 2 pairs the score was 245 for no wickets.

Third pair were Will Taylor and Jonathan Wellard. They faced one over from James (who had bowled the opening over) and Jonathan was well bowled by a great ball. They then kept him out for the rest of the over. After three pairs the scores were 253 for 1.

Final pair were Thomas and Sam Taylor. Like their team mates they played some very sensible cricket and ran well between the wickets. Thomas hit a 4 and together they added 35 to the score, with Panthers finishing on 288 for 1.
