The rematch!

With the Leopards top of the League and the Panthers second everyone had been looking forward to this match. The Leopards won the toss and put the Panthers into bat.

Panthers Innings

The Panthers had 9 players, and Drew kindly agreed to sharing the overs. This meant that Finn, Will T, Will J, Sunny and Sam C shared the middle eight overs.

First in were Ben and Sam Taylor. Facing overs from Jack, Harrison, Danny and Millie they found it hard to score runs and Sam was caught by Morgan off the bowling of Danny. After one pair the Panthers were still on 200. Ben finished on 2 n.o. and Sam 2 for 1.

The middle five batsmen also struggled against some first class bowling and fielding with Finn scoring the most (7 including a 4). With a wicket each for Millie and Will W, and two each for Sam F and Ben T the score went backwards so that after 12 overs the Panthers were 184 for 7.

Last in were Thomas and Sam Trellis. Facing two overs from Jack and one each from Ben T and Harrison they did well to each score a boundary in an inninnings of 5 runs each. Ben T struck for the third and fourth times bowling both batsmen and Harrison bowled a very fast wicket maiden.

Panthers finished on 183 for 10. Lower than the 244 for 7 last time, but the Leopards had bowled as well as Parley A the week before.

Special mention to Morgan who did a fantastic job behind the stumps stopping a lot of very fast balls. He also got a catch.

Leopards Innings

First pair in were Danny and Ben. Facing overs from Ben J, Sam Taylor, Thomas and Sam Trellis, Danny played an exceptional inninnings scoring 32 n.o. To peg things back a little, Ben J got a great caught and bowled to Ben T and Will was unlucky not to get a run out. After one pair Leopards were on 238 for 1.

Next in were Millie and Morgan. They faced four really well bowled overs - two each from Finn and Sam C. In the first over Ben J got a run-out from a gear piece of fielding and Thomas took an excellent catch to give Finn a wicket maiden in two overs that only conceded 1 run. After two pairs the score stood at 238 for 3.

The third pair were Will W and Jack. Facing overs from Sam Trellis, two from Will J and one from Sunny they batted well to add 25 to the score for the loss of only one wicket.

Last pair in were Harrison and Sam F. With overs from Thomas, Ben J, Sam Taylor and a final over from Ben J, Harrison was determined to score some runs. The bowlers really thought about what they doing mixing up the speed and line of the ball and stopped Harrison scoring any sixes in an innings of 28 that included 5 fours. In the last over Ben J managed to trap Harrison lbw on the back foot going for a big 6.

Leopards finished on 296 for 5. Panthers did an excellent job in the field, bowling and fielding really well despite having scored such a low score.

Points

Leopards got 10 points for winning and 9 batting bonus points. Panthers got no points this week.

With bowling figures of 1 for 6 of two overs and 32 n.o. off 16 balls, the man of the match was Danny Gunn.
