RULES

- 1 Games are played based on “out is out” rules with a hardball.
- 2 A player must retire once they have scored 15 and can return.
- 3 A team can bat twice within the batting time, if the team are out within 45 minutes. The batting order cannot change in the second innings on returning to the crease. Note a retired batsman can bat again as the first player back in, following all team wickets falling to reward the player for getting 15 runs . If more than two retire it's the first to retire who bats again first.
- 4 There are no LBW's in this format.
- 5 The team bowling first will bowl for 45 minutes.
- 6 The bowlers must bowl one over each, and cannot bowl again until every team member (except the wicket keeper) has bowled their over.
- 7 At the end of the 45 minutes the team batting second will receive the same amount of overs that were bowled to them, unless they have bowled out before 45 minutes are up, whereupon the team batting second will receive a maximum of 16 overs.
- 8 Wides and no balls costs two runs with no extra balls. These do not count towards the batsman.

- 9 The winner of the game is the team with the highest score. The Winning team receives three points the losing team one.
- 10 If the scores are level the game is drawn. 2 points are given to each team.

FIXTURES

All matches will be played on C2.

22 June 2010 - New Zealand Vs Australia

Team West Indies will undertake training with one of the coaches.

29 June 2010 - West Indies Vs New Zealand

Team Australia will undertake training with one the the spare coaches.

13 July 2010 West Indies vs. Australia

Team New Zealand will undertake training with one of the coaches.

If any game is cancelled due to weather then both sides will receive 2 points.

Please note on the 20/7/2010 there will be training but a large number of under 10's might be playing the semi final of the East Dorset Cup.
