Wild Cats Innings

She recovered well from this to hit 3 fours in her innings to finish on 13-1. George was 0no, defending a well bowled maiden over from Ben J. After three pairs the score was 267-1.

Last pair were Rhys and Tom. They batted well with Rhys hitting four 4s, before going for a big slog on the last ball and getting out lbw to Ben J. Rhys finished on 18-1 and Tom on 2no.

The Wildcats finished on 289-2. A good score.

Pumas Innings

First pair were Guy and Nathan, who faced good bowling from Finn and Tom. Guy was bowled in the opening over from Finn – a wicket maiden – and ended on 6-1, while Nathan was 3no. The score was 213-1, 12 behind the Wildcats.

Second pair were Sam and George. They added 22, but there were some scares as they risked run-outs a few times!! In the last over George was bowled by George, but played some nice shots to finish on 4/1. Sam was 18no with three 4s, and the score was 235-2, 23 behind.

Third pair were Lawrence and Ben S. They ran really well, until the last over when Lawrence misjudged a run and ran Ben S out. Lawrence finished on 3no, and Ben on 5-1, but they also ran 6 byes. The score was 256-3, 11 behind.

Fourth pair were Ben J and Josh needing 34 to win. Doable if they kept their wickets. Lewis bowled the first over and bowled Ben with a ball that brushed the stumps. The first over added a net nil. 34 still needed. Christian then bowled a great over, conceding only 3 runs and bowling Josh with the last ball. The Pumas were going backwards, and now needed 37 off 2 overs. Tom then conceded 13, leaving 24 needed of the last over. Ben hit the first ball for 4, and managed one more 4, but Finn bowled really well to leave the Pumas 10 runs short. Ben finished on 19-1 and Josh 3-1.

The Pumas finished on 279-5.
